



Camp LeafBridge is an activity-based summer camp for students with significant physical and cognitive disabilities. This unique program offers high levels of support while addressing Individualized Education Program (IEP) goals through Extended School Year (ESY) services. Camp activities are planned and coordinated by specialists in the areas of special education, physical/occupational/speech therapies, and assistive technology.

Camp LeafBridge promotes progress and minimizes loss of skills for students:

- with multiple and complex disabilities
- who require low or 1:1 staff to student ratios
- with newly emerging skills
- with excessive absences during the school year
- who require highly skilled assistive technology services

Common goal areas addressed at Camp LeafBridge:

- Communication/Social Skills
- Self-Care
- Mobility
- Pre-vocational skills
- Assistive technology for daily living, computer access, communication, vision, mobility, and education
- Transition skills
