Campers can participate in day, overnight, and year-round respite programs to foster independence, build self-confidence, and forge new friendships.

REX LAKE OVERNIGHT CAMP PROGRAMS

A week of Overnight Camp is packed full of adventure, campfires, fun, and friends! Children and adults with disabilities learn new skills, develop friendships, and gain independence through this one-week experience. While at camp, campers participate in traditional camping activities, which include swimming, kayaking, campfires, songs, crafts, games, and much, much more!

Children's Overnight Camp - Cost/Week \$1,100

Our children's Overnight Camp is our cornerstone program. Since 1924 children with disabilities have enjoyed a weeklong get away on the Portage Lakes. Today, the program is open to all children with disabilities and their siblings. At our children's Overnight Camps there are two (2) counselors to every six (6) campers. The goals of Overnight Camp are to increase camper's independence and self-esteem, encourage campers to try new leisure activities and become more physically active, and develop social skills. These goals are accomplished through the natural dynamics of the overnight camp experience, intentional programming and staff leadership.

Adult Overnight Camp - Cost/Week \$1,100

Our adult camps are the fastest growing programs each summer. These overnight experiences are designed for campers 18 and over. Many of the campers have "graduated" from the children's program and wish to continue to be a part of the Rotary Camp family. Others have never been to camp before and are looking for a non-traditional vacation that promotes independence, socialization, and just plain fun! There are two (2) counselors to every eight (8) adult campers in this specific program. Campers are able to register for two (2) weeks.
